IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DONORS TO OPPOSE NATIONAL CITY RENT CONTROL

CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTING: Your contribution to National City Residents for Fair & Equitable Housing will be disclosed on campaign finance reports filed by the committee and may also need to be reported on campaign finance reports filed separately by you as the contributor.

Committee Reporting: For contributions of \$5,000 or more, the committee must report the contribution within 10 business days of receipt. In the 90 days prior to the election, the committee must report contributions of \$1,000 or more within 24 hours of receipt. In addition, all contributions received during the period will be reported on periodic campaign finance reports due April 30, July 31, September 27, October 25, 2018, and January 31, 2019.

Your Reporting: Individuals or entities that contribute \$10,000 or more in the aggregate in a calendar year to state or local candidates, ballot measures, political parties, and PACs, are required to file their own campaign finance reports, known as "[Major Donor Reports](#)." Contributions to the committee will count toward the \$10,000 threshold.

These reports are due July 31, 2018 and January 31, 2019. In addition, in the 90 days prior to an election, Major Donors are also required to report certain contributions of \$1,000 or more within 24 hours of making of the contribution.

Reimbursement/Source of Funds: Under California law, we are required to disclose the true source of funds used to make contributions. For example, if a property management company obtains reimbursement for its contribution from an affiliated real estate owner, both the property management company and the real estate owner must be disclosed. Accordingly, if you seek reimbursement for your contribution, in whole or in part, from other entities or individuals, please provide us with: (1) the amount of the contribution that was reimbursed; and (2) the legal name and address of the reimbursing entity or individual. Please also note that contributions from foreign entities and foreign nationals are prohibited.

Earmarking: As noted above, California law requires the true source of the contribution to be disclosed. For that reason, contributions cannot be made through a trade association or other intermediary to hide the identity of the donor. Even if contributions are made through other entities, the committee is required to disclose the funds as being from the initial donor.

Loans: Loans to the committee are considered contributions and will be reported as described above.

TOP TEN DISCLOSURE: A list of the top ten contributors of \$10,000 or more to the committee will be publicly available at: fppc.ca.gov/transparency/top-contributors/nov-18-gen1.html. The committee must regularly update this list.

ADVERTISING DISCLAIMERS: The top three contributors of \$50,000 or more to the committee will be identified in committee advertisements, including mailings, TV and radio ads, and paid phone calls (certain ads require the identification of the top two or the highest contributor) as part of the disclaimer. Please contact us if you would like to know whether your contribution would make you one of the top three contributors to the committee. The disclaimers differ based upon the medium, but generally they will include:
